To be considered for this award, each student must send a letter with the following information: name, academic affiliation, and status, title of paper or poster, and a statement outlining 1) approximate distance and mode of travel; 2) amount of current support from home institution and/or government, and 3) A brief statement of why we should consider you for one of the travel grants (no more than 100 words).

In addition, please provide the name, contact information (including email address) of at least one faculty member at the home institution that can confirm your status and level of funding.
